




# HOW TO MAINTAIN YOUR RAINWATER HARVESTING SYSTEM AT HOME



1. Regularly check and clean catchment area for debris
2. Clean gutters and downspouts at least twice a year
3. Inspect and clean the First Flush and Leaf Eater System regularly
4. Clean storage tank at least once a year to prevent algae and sediments
5. Check for and repair leaks in the system
6. Regularly inspect and clean pump
7. Visibly check water for discoloration and algae growth, mosquito lava and other living organisms
8. Teach family members about system maintenance
9. Keep a log of maintenance activities
